Match Details

Matches will be played over two-three weeks from 6 January including weekends. The schedule will be confirmed closer to the date.

Matches are 40 overs per team and games start at 10am and finish at 4.30-5 pm with a 40 minute lunch break scheduled from 12.50pm. Elsternwick competes in the South Group against Brighton, Caulfield, Malvern, Moorabbin, Oakleigh and Ormond. After the six preliminary rounds, the two top teams in the group progress to the quarter finals where they play against the top ranked teams of the North, East and West Groups.

Home games will be played on Elsternwick Park Oval No 1 (164 Glenhuntly Road, Elsternwick), which has recently been completely redeveloped and is now one of the premier cricket grounds in the region.

Players selected for the carnival are charged \$200 which partially offsets the cost of coaching, playing shirt, cap and shorts. Umpires fees are payable on a game by game basis for all matches.
